Pinwheels for Prevention[®] Cutout Pinwheel Activity

What You Need

Crayons to decorate Straight pin Pencil with eraser Scissors

Getting Started

Cut out the dashed square. Next cut in from each corner along the dashed line, leaving about two inches in the center uncut.

Assembly

Gently bend (do not fold) one corner to the center point. Skip the next corner and bend the following one. Repeat until four corners meet in the center. Push the straight pin through

all four points and the back of the pinwheel. Stick the pin into the pencil eraser. Find some wind and test it out!
