Jane F. Silovsky, PhD., Professor, is a clinical child psychologist and the Associate Director of the Center on Child Abuse and Neglect. Dr. Silovsky received her doctorate in clinical psychology from the University of Alabama. Currently, she is a Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center. Since 1997, she has been the Director of the Children with Sexual Behavior Problems program, an assessment, treatment, and research program for preschool and school age children with sexual behavior problems. Dr. Silovsky's research is in the area of treatment outcome and program evaluation of services for children affected by child maltreatment. One of her major research interests is sexual behavior problems of young children, and she has published on preschool and school age children with sexual behavior problems.

Lisa M. Swisher, PhD., Clinical Associate Professor, is a clinical child psychologist and a member of the faculty at the Center on Child Abuse and Neglect. Dr. Swisher received her doctorate in clinical psychology from Oklahoma State University. Currently, she is a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center. She has been involved with the Children with Sexual Behavior Problems (CSBP) program for school age children as therapist and/or Project Coordinator for over 10 years. The CSBP program is an assessment, treatment, and research program for preschool and school age children with sexual behavior problems. Dr. Swisher's research is in the area of juvenile delinquency and youth with inappropriate or illegal sexual behavior.

Keri Pierce, LCSW, MPH, is the project director for the National Center on Sexual Behavior of Youth and clinical coordinator for the Adolescents with Illegal Sexual Behaviors Program. She has also worked with treatment groups for preschool and school age children with sexual behavior problems. Ms. Pierce provides training to state providers through an annual conference focused specifically on the treatment on youth with sexual behavior problems funded by the state Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse. Ms. Pierce has presented locally, state-wide, and nationally on youth with sexual behavior problems and their various challenges. She also serves as one of the consultants for a program implementation project in South Carolina which serves Youth with Sexual Behavior Problems.
